

Green Oak Tortrix, European Oak Leaf-roller (continued)

Tortrix viridana Linnaeus

Tortricidae: Tortricinae: Tortricini

Description of Adult

- Forewing length 8-10 mm.
- The forewing is nearly uniform bright green with few or no markings, and the hindwing is grayish with a narrow fringe of whitish scales around the margin. There is no sexual dimorphism in size, color, or pattern.
- Male genitalia with uncus absent; socii large; valva somewhat parallel-sided with a well developed sacculus.
- Female genitalia with “floricomous” ovipositor (i.e., papillae anales with a section of flat-headed setae), with broad papillae anales. Apophyses very short; ductus bursae rather uniform in width and fairly long; corpus bursae small and rounded, with a small stellate signum.
